**2010** was a busy year for RCF.

The Foundation revisited its strategic plan and created a marketing plan to attract new funds to benefit the community. We restructured our administrative fees, worked closely with the First Financial Northwest Foundation to award 283,000 in grants, helped to launch The Next Curve (the next generation of community leaders), played a key role in helping to launch the Friends of Renton Schools, relocated our offices to the Liberty Park Building downtown and received a large bequest from the Helen Dyrdal estate to begin a new scholarship program. We disbursed over \$733,000 back to the community and exceeded \$6 million in assets!

**Stay**-tuned in 2011 as we work to find new donors, identify priority needs, establish new programs and continue to build a healthy future for Renton.
